

ANNUAL REPORT

- I am very elated and privileged to present the annual report of NTR model school being run by the noble trustees of NTR memorial trust. I shall present the overall performance of NTR Model School in a nutshell within the permitted time to the august gathering here.
- This school was primarily instituted to meet the educational needs of the needy parent less children by our visionary leader Shri Nara Chandrababu Naidu Garu in the year 2005 with a meagre strength of 130 students under the state board of the then state of Andhra Pradesh. It was run under the state board until the academic year 2015-16. Later the school was converted into CBSE stream from the academic year 2016-17.
- Presently the school is consisting of classes 6th to 10th with a strength of 540 students with only day scholar facility for boys and both residential and day scholar facility for girls.

ACADEMIC (Curricular)

- Every academic year we are achieving cent percent results in class X board exams both in state as well as CBSE. This year too 126 students of class X are going to appear CBSE board exams which are to begin from February 15th. Even this year we are committed to achieve 100% result with few students in GPA 10/10.
- During the academic year 2022-23 Ch. Jyotsna D/o. Ch. Anil Kumar has achieved 9.8 overall GPA in 2023 CBSE X class board exam.
- Master G. Vamsi Yadav S/o. G. Venkatesh of our school is pursuing MBBS in Osmania Medical college, Koti-Hyderabad.
- One more student Pasula Divya who passed out from here is pursuing her MBBS in Pratima Medical College, Warangal.
- N. Anusha D/o. Balu of 2021 batch is selected for IIT Mumbai and is pursuing her mechanical engineering.
- Master N.D. Sai Teja S/o. Mr. Govind who is also our maths senior faculty in our college has secured state 132 rank in IIIT entrance examination last year.

- Many students participated in book review competition held by the BREAD (basic research education and development) society of India and have won laurels and certificates.



- 2 students from class X are selected for Pariksha-pe-charcha i.e. interactive session with prime minister of India at New Delhi and 84 students have received certificates of participation. This year it's going to be held on 29th February by the Prime minister of India.



Co-Curricular

- Along with the academic programme students are also encouraged to participate in various internal and external co-curricular activities and competitions.
- Every week on Saturday various activities and competitions like quiz, elocution, singing, dancing, paper craft, usage of wastage productively are some of the activities which are conducted.
- Three students O. Srinivas Reddy, K. Sravanthi & S. Gnaneshwar Reddy from class X qualified Aryabhata National Maths competition held on 21st May, 2023



- 3 of our students along with Mr. Tirumal Rao, Social teacher have participated in G-20 summit on life skills conducted by CBSE at Silver Oaks International School at Bachupally-Hyderabad.



- Ch. Vinamratha Jyothi who completed class 10 here, is the only 1 student from Telangana state to get admitted in to Satya sai educational Institute at Puttaparthi during the previous academic year.
- Ch. Vinamratha Jyothi received Bala Puraskar Award from Rotary club of cantonment Hyderabad-3153



EXTRA CURRICULAR COMPETITIONS

- All the students of the school are provided additional coaching in Karate, Dance, Music and Yoga as per their choice. 2 days in a week the students are trained by professional teacher. Many students have participated in number of competitions outside. 2 students have even gone to national level karate competition under 52 kg at Vishakhapatnam and Master S. Ganeswer has won the gold medal.



- 44 students have participated in district level karate competition held at Shankarpally. Overall championship was awarded to our students which was conducted by Success Shotokan karate of India.
- All the students in the school are segregated into 4 houses viz. Mother Teresa, Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose, Bhagath Singh and NTR Houses. Inter house competitions are held periodically. As a part of it 2 girl students namely M. Akshaya and B. Spandana of class IX have been selected for district level Volleyball competition held at Khammam.
- S. Vidya Charan of class VIII has played in State level under 14 cricket tournaments from the state of Telangana which was conducted in Uttar Pradesh.
- In overall inter house competitions held NTR house stands in 1st place and Bhagath Singh house stands in 2nd place.
- **NCC:** From the academic year 2019-20 NCC is introduced in the school under 3T battalion Hyderabad group. A batch of 25 students (15JD & 10JW) are recruited every year and they are given NCC 'A' certificate at the end of 2 years training.

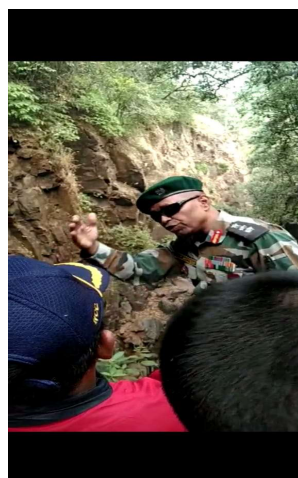

Mr. Lingaiah our social teacher is selected as CTO for NCC cadets under 3T battalion. He has undergone the NCC officer's training for 45 days at NCC officers training academy in Kamptee-Maharashtra. He is appointed as 3rd officer of NCC to train our NCC cadets.

SOCIAL SERVICE & Eco Club ACTIVITIES

Many of our students and staff along with NCC cadets have participated in Swachhata-hi-sewa programme on the campus and in the village of Himayathnagar in which Sarpanch, Dy. Sarpanch, ward members and villagers have taken part.



Eco club is instituted with selected students from all classes under the guidance of Mrs. Kamala Jyothi Plantation programme was organized in the campus and in the vicinity of village. A rally was taken up within the village to bring awareness and importance of safeguarding our environment.



Blood donation drive was organized in the school premises by NTR memorial trust on the occasion of Birthday of our mentor Shri Nara Chandra Babu Naidu garu on 20th April, wherein students have participated in conduction of the programme and many donors along with TDP sympathizers from surrounding villages have participated in this noble event.
